Dear Management and Team,

Thank you for the email and information.

We note the contents of your email with disappointment, particularly considering our flexibility with the agreed terms, especially timelines, throughout the project duration, contrasted with Market Kinetics consistent failure to fulfil their commitments as per those timelines. This further delay poses significant financial implications for us, compounding our challenges, as we have proceeded with financial commitments based on the expectation that the promised refund would be executed by March 15, 2024.

It's important to acknowledge that an employee's commitment/statements retain their significance and accountability, irrespective of any inadvertent inaccuracies.

While we appreciate the suggestion to expedite the payment, we find it reasonable to request an immediate partial refund, with the balance to be settled by June. Hence, we request that at least 50% of the refund be processed without delay, with the remaining 50% disbursed by the agreed-upon date of June 15, 2024.

Provided below are the banking details for the prompt wire transfer of the initial sum. We anticipate a swift and amicable resolution to this matter and appreciate your cooperation and understanding.

Market Kinetics is under new management and ownership as of March 1, 2024. Mr. Courtney Olujobi is no longer with the company and Mr. Shirona A Gunawardhana is in a limited advisory role during the transition. We are expecting the transition to take 60 to 90 days.

We noticed that there is a request for a refund of US\$ 61,000 (sixty one thousand) filed on January 6, 2024. According to the agreement you signed with Market Kinetics the refunds are issued within 180 (one hundred and eighty) days.

Mr. Olujobi by a mistake has provided you a refund by date of March 15, 2024. Per the agreement, the due date should be July 5, 2024. Mr. Gunawardhana however has advised us to expedite the payment. The management has agreed to initiate the refund of US\$ 61,000 (sixty one thousand) by June 15, 2024.

Please provide us the banking information to wire the US\$ 61,000 (sixty one thousand). Our sincere apologies for the miscommunication.

Dear Directors/Partners/Management,

We are writing once again to request an update regarding the refund of US\$61,000 owed to [REDACTED] [REDACTED], which was due on the mutually agreed upon date of July 5, 2024, in line with our signed agreement.

Despite multiple assurances that the refund would be processed by the agreed-upon date, nearly three months have elapsed without any communication or update from your side.

Could you kindly provide an update on the status of this matter and your intentions moving forward? We are open to discussing a mutually agreeable plan if necessary.

This delay is causing significant concern and strain among our shareholders, who engaged in this agreement in good faith based on trust and your word. Additionally, we have made attempts to communicate with you via mail but have not received any response.

In the spirit of transparency, as indicated by [REDACTED] earlier, we were working with a consortium of financiers that progressed to an advanced stage. As part of our engagement with them, [REDACTED] was required to make a financial commitment that we are currently unable to meet without the refunded amount. This delay in refunding on the agreed dates has caused significant operational disruptions, commitments and has now affected our engagement and ability to consummate the transaction with interested lenders.

We were also promised that should funding be unsuccessful, , we would be provided with a copy of the list of all investors accessible through the Black Card Fund Launch Program, for which we made a payment to MK. This also has not been received.

We acknowledge your previous statements indicating that the refund would be honoured, yet it was declined on the due date. If there is a legitimate reason for this, we are willing to discuss alternative arrangements. However, if the commitment is not to be upheld, we will be compelled to escalate this matter to our equity partners who committed the funds. This includes providing them with all relevant correspondence, agreements, and recorded calls, including a conversation with Mr. Shirona Gunawardhana, in which he was aware of the recording and affirmed the commitment to the refund. Please note, this is only a reflection of their advisors' comments and is not intended for any other purpose. We are keen to resolve this matter amicably and avoid any escalation to legal or public channels.

Again, we simply and respectfully request that MK honours the signed agreement, as we have consistently done throughout our engagement.

We trust that you understand the gravity of the situation and will take the necessary steps to ensure a prompt resolution. Kindly provide an update on your decision via return email by close of business September 27, 2024, or earlier.
